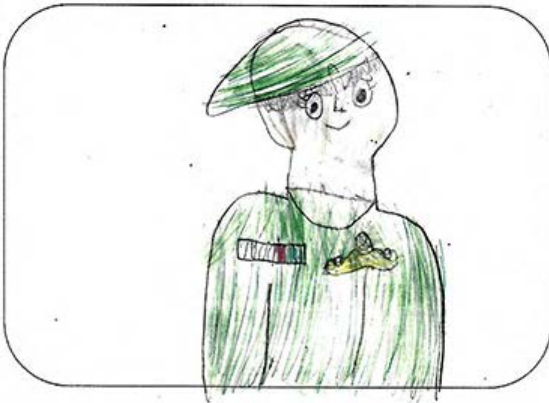
In this special Remembrance edition of the newsletter we are sharing the children's research, poems and creativity to commemorate the fallen.

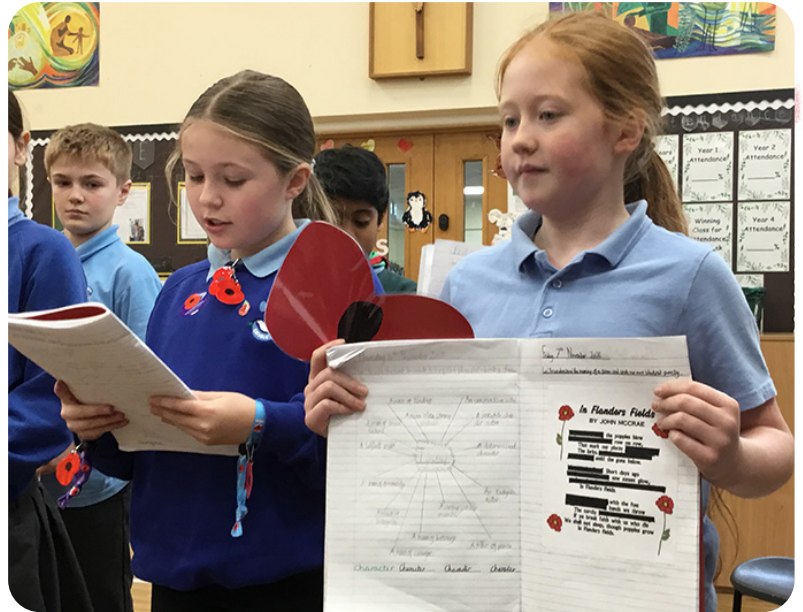
Name: Ian Harvey

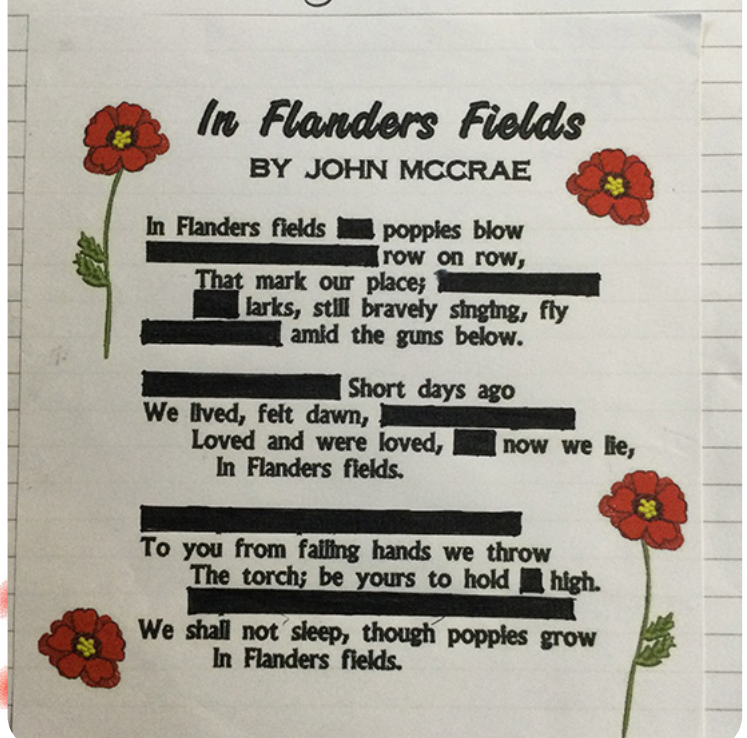
