What's covered?

The session will cover why sleep is essential for children's learning, behaviour, and emotional wellbeing, and will explore common sleep challenges for primary aged children. Parents will be guided through creating consistent bedtime routines, managing screen use, and setting up a sleep-friendly environment, with time for discussion and questions. The workshop will also provide simple tools parents can use straight away to help their children settle more easily and get the sleep they need. This is a parent only workshop.
